More than 500 schools with RN-BSN programs were reviewed and ranked utilizing several criteria that included program costs, outcomes, student debt and earnings, reputation, and more. Data was collected from trusted sources such as the Commission on Collegiate Nursing Education (CCNE) and the Accreditation Commission for Education in Nursing (ACEN), as well as government resources including the Integrated Postsecondary Education Data System (IPEDS) and the U.S. Department of Education’s College Scorecard.
